1. Pandurang Khankhoje (1883-1967)

Why in news – LS Speaker Om Birla would unveil a statue of the freedom fighter Khankhoje during his visit to Mexico.

Key Points –

- He would also unveil statues of Swami Vivekananda.
- He was currently in Canada for the 65th Commonwealth Parliamentary Conference.

About Khankhoje –

- He was a Maharashtra-born (Wardha) freedom fighter and agriculturalist.
- He sought refuge in Mexico due to his association with Ghadar Party.
- He was an ardent admirer of the French Revolution and of the American War of Independence.
- He was one of the founding members of the Ghadar Party (1914).
- 2. Football CoA dissolved

Why in news - The Supreme Court dissolved the Committee of Administrators (CoA) appointed to look after the daily affairs of AIFF.

Key Points –

- It paved the way for FIFA to lift suspension imposed on AIFF.
- CoA was a 3-member body headed by Sunando Dhar.

3. Mystery paddy dwarfing

Why in news - Scientists tracked the cause of paddy dwarfing in Punjab and Haryana.

Key Points -

- IARI has undertaken electron microscopy analysis and DNA isolation through PCR (polymerase chain reaction) technique.
- Reason for dwarfing Either grassy stunt virus or phytoplasma bacteria.
- Vector Brown plant hopper.
- 4. Tomato Flu
 - Why in news India has recorded cases of tomato flu in Kerala.

Key Points –

- It was first identified in Kerala's Kollam district on May 6, 2022.
- Symptoms rashes, skin irritation and dehydration.
- It could be an after-effect of chikungunya or dengue fever in children.

1. IS bomber detained

Why in news – Russia has detained an Islamic State (IS) suicide bomber planning to target a key Indian politician.

Key Points –

- He was detained by Russia's Federal Security Service (FSB).
- Mouthpiece of Islamic State Khurasan Province (ISKP) - Al Azaim Foundation.

2. Soviet-era obelisk

Why in news – Latvia to tear down a Soviet-era monument that commemorates the Red Army's victory over Nazi Germany.

Key Points –

- It has an 80-meter (260-foot) concrete spire with a Soviet star on top.
- It was built in 1985 while Latvia (Capital-Riga) was still part of the Soviet Union.
- Last week, Estonia (capital-Tallinn) removed a Soviet-era monument.

3. Unveiling of bust of Mahatma Gandhi

Why in news – EAM S Jaishankar has unveiled a bust of Mahatma Gandhi in Paraguay.

Key Points-

- He also visited the historic Casa de la Independencia from where Paraguay 's Independence movement started.
- S. Jaishankar is on a visit to Paraguay and Argentina.

SCIENCE – TECH

1. Hydrogen fuel cell bus

Why in news – Union Minister Dr. Jitendra Singh launched India's first indigenously developed Hydrogen fuel cell bus in Pune.

Key Points –

- It was developed by KPIT-CSIR.
- He also inaugurated the Bisphenol-A pilot plant in CSIR-NCL.
- 12-14% of CO₂ emissions and particulate emissions come from diesel-powered heavy commercial vehicles.

2. Monkeypox test kit

Why in news – India's first indigenouslydeveloped RT-PCR kit for testing Monkeypox was launched at the Andhra Pradesh Medtech Zone (AMTZ).

Key Points -

- Name Transasia-Erba monkeypox RT-PCR kit.
- It was developed by Transasia Bio-Medicals.
- It was unveiled by Principal Scientific Adviser Ajay Kumar Sood.

ENVIRONMENT

1. Night Safari

Why in news – India's first night safari to come up in Lucknow.

Key Points -

• It would be developed in 350 acres in the Kukrail forest area.

- Behesti terminal is a crucial cog in the International North South Transport Corridor (INSTC).
- Chabahar Port is currently operated by state-owned India Ports Global.

RESIGNATIONS

1. Anthony Fauci

Why in news – Dr. Anthony Fauci would step down from his positions as director of NIAID and chief medical adviser to Joe Biden.

Key Points –

- NIAID National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases.
- He has been the NIAID director since 1984.
- In 2020, he was the face of the US government's efforts to contain the Covid-19 pandemic.

1. Low rainfall in Bihar

Why in news - Monsoon has lost its way due to which there was less rain in Jharkhand and Bihar.
